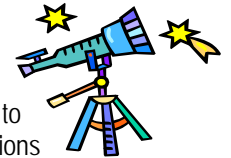

PAYMENT

Payment accepted by cash, Interac, VISA, MasterCard or money order payable to Edmonton Space & Science Foundation

REGISTRATION DEPOSIT

A \$50 non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit is required at the time of registration with final payment due on arrival.

For Sleepover Bookings, a deposit of \$100 is required at time of booking, with final payment due on arrival. One adult chaperone is required for every five children for Sleepovers.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The \$50/\$100 deposit will not be refunded in the event of cancellation
